## **Bipartisan Bill Introduced to Shed Light on Corporate Secrecy**

Today, Senator Carl Levin and Senator Charles Grassley introduced the Incorporation Transparency and Law Enforcement Assistance Act, which would require corporations to provide information about who owns or controls the corporation and benefits from its existence.

WASHINGTON – "By introducing the Incorporation Transparency and Law Enforcement Assistance Act, Senators Levin and Grassley have demonstrated the great results that come from thoughtful, bipartisan work and plain common sense. The United States cannot expect cooperation from other countries when it comes to corporate accountability, transparency and tax reporting while looking the other way here at home. We've got to be a leader on these counts. Anonymous corporations provide a safe haven for drug traffickers, terrorists, tax dodgers and should not be a tolerated here or abroad."
